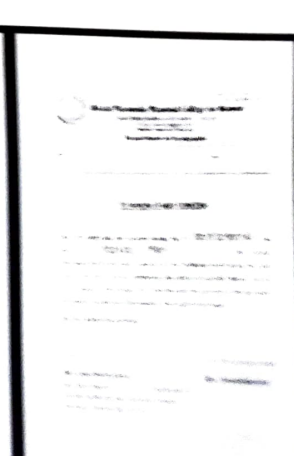
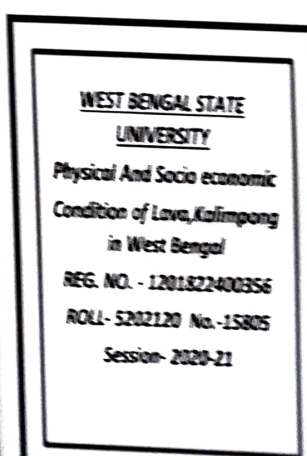
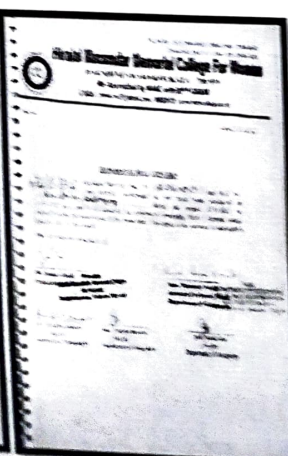
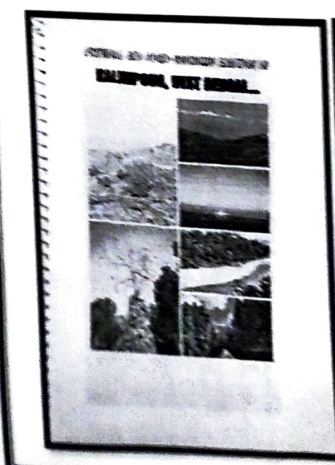
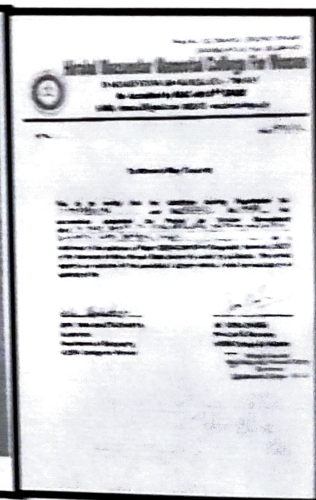
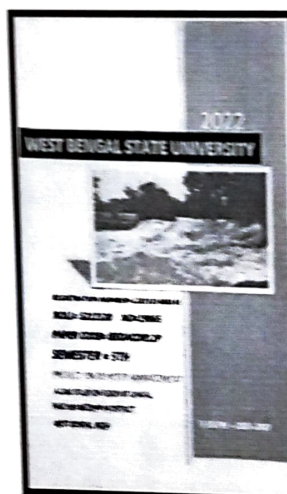
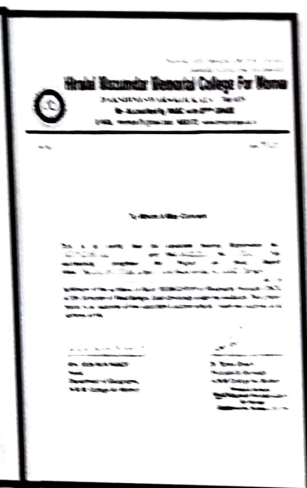
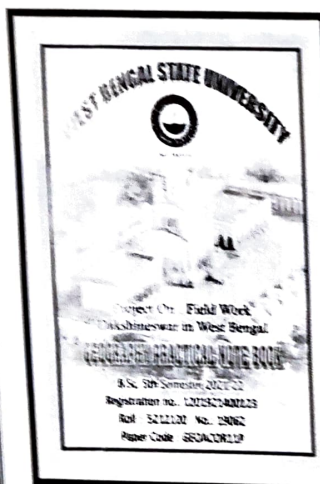
# OUTCOME:
