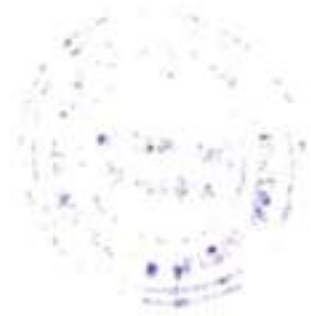

This MOU shall be identified as the parent document of any programme agreement executed between the parties. The terms of Understanding for each specific activity implemented under this agreement shall be mutually discussed agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation







The above collaboration will include all the Departments, Faculties of both HMMCW and GGGDC.


Terms of MOU:

- C. The First Party may donate books to the Second Party, as per availability.


III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS



BOTH FIRST & SECOND PARTIE's be individually referred to as "PARTY" and collectively as "Parties or Consortium".

9. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

1. 3. 2. Upon termination or expiration of this Agreement, the receiving Party shall return or destroy/ remove/ handover/ delete all the Confidential Information kept in its possession to the disclosing Party and furnish a proof of such removal/ handover/ deletion of the Confidential Information. For any Confidential Information, which is not commercially practicable to be returned or destroyed shall continue to be bound by this obligation of confidentiality post expiration or termination of this Agreement.

11. NON DISCLOSURE

No Party shall disclose any information to any third party concerning the matters under this MOU. Any proprietary information (properly identified as such by the disclosing Party) to be contained in reports or disclosed by one Party to the other Party, shall be kept strictly confidential by the receiving Party, and shall not be disclosed to any third party without the prior written consent of the original disclosing Party. This clause shall not apply where –

- a) Disclosure is made to the employees, or
- b) disclosure to any court/ tribunal/ Central or State Government or any other statutory/ quasi-judicial authorities or other bodies to the extent required by law, guidelines, rules or regulations applicable to any Party,
- c) required to consultants, advisers engaged by a Party,
- d) Information is already in public domain but not as a result of breach of this MOU, already available with the Party from other lawful sources.

This clause shall survive the termination or expiry of the MOU.



Now, this Agreement witnesses the following terms & conditions to be performed by both the parties to the Agreement.

1. The First Party has agreed to pick up, transport, carry and recycle/dispose of the E-Waste from the second party as per the norms prescribed by the Government Authorities from time to time.
2. The First Party has agreed to make available Utilization Certificate confirming that E-Waste provided by the Second party to the First Party has been recycled/ disposed of as per the norms prescribed by the Government Authorities within 60 days of the pick up the E-Waste

6. The Second Party has agreed to pay an 'agreement fee' of ₹ 7,000 /- + 18%GST annually to the first party as fee for the contract. Total of ₹ 21,000 /- + 18%GST to be paid one time in advance. Rent for 3 years of the E-waste Bin and Awareness Session included.
7. The Second Party will accumulate all E-Waste and inform to the first party once reasonable volume (approx. 500 kgs minimum) has accumulated. The pickups confirmed by the Second Party will be carried out on a priority basis within Five days from the date of request.
8. The Second party has agreed to handover the E-Waste items, the details of which are mentioned here below to the first party on "as is where is basis". The first party will dispose off such equipment and specifically agreed that they will charge the second party.
9. **a) The first party shall pay in case of the items in ANNEXURE 1.**
Any monies payable by the First party will be identified and settled within 3 working days of actual pick up after clearance of all aligned necessary documents. (Tax Invoices, signed Logistics Sheet and E-waste manifest documents)
- b) The Second party shall pay in case of the items in ANNEXURE 2** As the items are negative items and are required to be recycled as per the norm of the PCB for recycling negative items.
10. The second party's responsibility will cease once electronic waste has been handed over to the First Party as per clause 3 above. Thereafter, no liability would accrue to the Second party on account of e-waste.
