- 2. (a) Comment on the role of the Chorus in Sophocles' Oedipus the King.

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OR

(b) Write a brief essay on the dramatic irony in Sophocles' Oedipus the King.

SECTION-II

- 3. Write a short note on any *one* of the following in about 200 words:
 - (a) Quarrel between Achilles and Agamemnon in Homer's Iliad.
 - (b) Role of Tiresias in Sophocles' Oedipus the King.

SECTION-III

Answer each of the following in not more than 500 words:

4. (a) Divine retribution is a major theme in the storytelling of *Ovid's Metamorphoses*. Comment on how it is explored in Book III.

OR

(b) Write a note on the theme of transformation in the myth of Narcissus or Bacchus as delineated in Ovid's *Metamorphoses*, Book III.

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5. (a) What picture of contemporary society is evident in Plautus' play, *Pot of Gold*? Answer with close reference to the text.

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OR

(b) Discuss the character of Euclio in Pot of Gold.

6. Write a short note on any *one* of the following in about 200 words:

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- (a) Birth of Bacchus
- (b) Conclusion of Plautus' Pot of Gold.

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
