project is

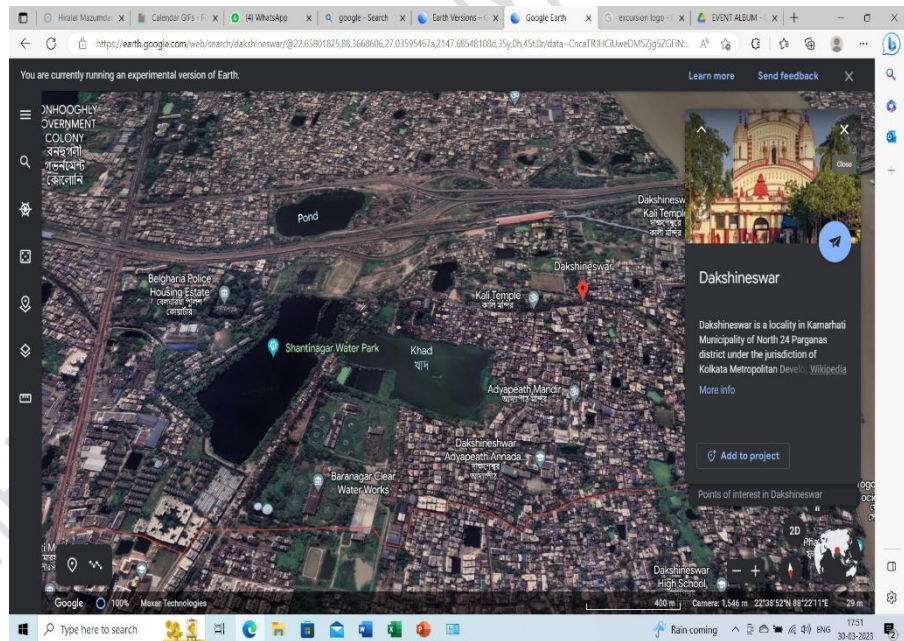
