HELD ON 1st AUGUST HELD AT THE
MEETING HALL OF THE COLLEGE:**

The Principal on the basis of the last meeting held at Bikash Bhavan on regarding RUSA funding intimated the meeting that the college needs to create an Account named RUSA 2.0, register for GST and IRMS for the money to be disbursed by RUSA and to be accessed by the college.

After successful registration, necessary software would be made available to the college where the utilization has to be uploaded with bills and vouchers. After clearance of the bill, the amount to be paid against the work done would be transferred electronically to the account of the service provider. In case of any cost escalation, the balance amount would have to be borne by the college. Three pixes taken at the inception, when the work is still in progress and on completion would have to be uploaded on the portal for clearance. Dr Ghosh, the Principal also informed the meeting that no deviations in fund sharing were allowed amongst the broad subheads. However, small changes could be incorporated within the subhead components. The amount of Rs 1 crore would be disbursed as first instalment. After 70 per cent utilization of the first instalment, the institution would be allowed to seek the second instalment from RUSA.


E-Tendering has to be floated for any activity to be funded through RUSA. A logo has to be put on any item procured, constructed renovated by this fund.



She also noted that she has already sent a letter (2482/HMMC/PWD/2018-19) dated 30.11.2018 (*Annexure 4*) to the Executive Engineer, PWD (North Division), Govt of West Bengal, Kolkata requesting PWD to begin and finish the civil construction and renovation works on the earliest so that we can submit the Utilization Certificate to the RUSA by March 2019. The proposal has been accepted vide Memo No 2203/KND/Works/HMMCCollege/H-13 dated 5.12.18. (*Annexure 5*)
- b) Another letter 2483/HMMC/PWD (Electrical)/2018-19 dated 30.11.18 sent to the Executive Engineer, Electrical Department, PWD (North Division), (*Annexure 6*) Govt. of West Bengal has requested to take up the work of Renovation and Upgradation of electric wiring and electrification of the college (item 2E(e) of the RUSA DPR), execute and complete the job so that Utilization Certificate can be submitted to RUSA by March 2019.
- c) The PWD has agreed to issue NOC for installing the Public Address System (item 2E(f) of the RUSA DPR) and the renovation of cool and safe drinking water (item no 2C of the RUSA DPR) on the basis of letter no 2484/HMMC/PWD /2018-19 dated 30.11.18 seeking NOC (*Annexure 7*). 

The meeting assembled to open the E-tender call uploaded on 13.12.18 for Laboratory Equipments (Phase I) (Item Number 3D of DPR) and Library Books (Item Number 3A of DPR).

The call for these E-tenders was advertised in the English Newspaper the Times of India and Vernacular Newspaper Eisomoy dated 15.12.18.

The results of the tender are as follows.

1. For the laboratory equipment category (Item Number 3D for DPR) three bidders cleared the technical specification clearance and for library books category (Item Number 3A of DPR) five bidders got the technical clearance.

The financial bids were opened after that.

- a) In the laboratory equipment category (Item Number 3D for DPR), three quotations were not generated for any single item. The outcome of the E-Tender for any in the laboratory equipment category could not be accepted,

The meeting resolved that as per the Government of West Bengal, Finance Department, Audit Branch notification 6989-f(y) dated 19th November, 2018, all laboratory equipment as specified in the DPR had to be submitted for E-Tendering on the earliest.

This would be treated as the Second Call.

- b) In the Library Books category there were five bidders. All documents that were specified in the BOQ were submitted by all five bidders. However, Trio Enterprises did not submit Annexure X, Y and Z as were required in the E-Tendering Process.

- (i) The PMU, T&P and IQAC resolved that Trio Enterprises be asked to submit the required papers within the next three working days failing which their bid would remain to stand cancelled. This was done keeping in mind the fact the reputation of Trio Enterprises and the fact that the process has to speed up for completion of the process by the financial year 2018-19. In the financial bid of the E-Tender for library books which were opened on 3rd January, 2019 there were three successful bids for all 27 items.

The meeting resolved that the portal has identified the bidder who has promised the lowest discount as the L1 bidder, but for procurement of books, the bidder who has promised the highest discount percentage should be the L1 bidder. So the BOQ has to be treated in the descending order of the discount percentage. So CIG Corporate Pvt Ltd was asked to make necessary changes in the E-tendering process.



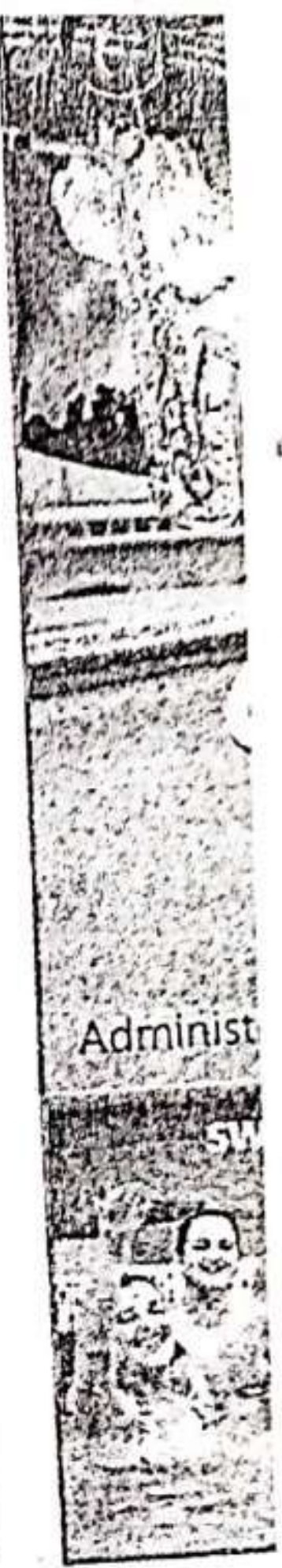

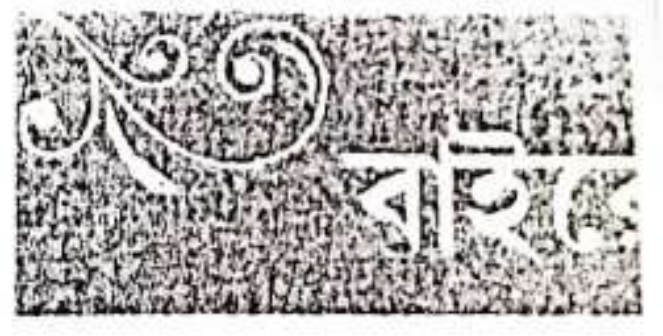

Rupee up 7 paise against USD

MUMBAI, JAN 28/--/The Indian rupee on Monday managed to end 7 paise higher at 71.10 against the US dollar on increased selling of the greenback by exporters amid easing crude oil prices and uptrend in other emerging market currencies. Also, fresh foreign fund inflows propped up the rupee. However, heavy selling in domestic equity market capped the gains of the local unit to some extent. At the Interbank Foreign Exchange (forex), the rupee opened on a firm note at 70.99 following dollar selling by exporters. However, the domestic currency found the initial gains and finally settled at 71.10, up 7 paise over its last close. The rupee Friday weakened by 10 paise to close at 71.17 against the US dollar. Crude oil prices fell on higher US crude oil production and slower global growth. The strength in Asian currencies against the American dollar also bode well for rupee as well, said V K Sharma, Head PCG and Capital Market Strategy, HDFC Securities. Brent crude, the global benchmark, was trading at USD 60.66 per barrel, lower by 1.58 per cent. Meanwhile, the dollar index, which gauges the greenback's strength against a basket of six currencies, was trading 0.05 per cent down at 95.74 after US President Donald Trump agreed on Friday to temporarily re-open the federal government. Trump backed a deal to temporarily end the record-breaking government shutdown in America's history despite getting no funding for his controversial plan to build a wall along the US-Mexico border. The deal resolved the crippling 35-day closure but did not resolve the fight over his proposed border wall. Going ahead, traders said the US and China trade talks, Brexit parliamentary vote, FOMC monetary policy decision and India's interim budget are the key event to watch out for which could bring big volatility in the Forex market this week.

Sensex crashes over 368 points; financial stocks a top drag

MUMBAI, JAN 28/--/The benchmark BSE Sensex Monday plummeted over 368 points to close at 35,657 due to selling across the board on the hours amid volatile market sentiment days ahead of the Union Budget, which is widely believed to have some populist announcements. Also, the NSE Nifty tumbled 119 points to end at 10,661.55 amid weak global cues. Markets feel the populist measures in the upcoming budget will stray the government from fiscal consolidation path - triggering a caution among investors. A heavy selling pressure emerged mainly in banking, auto and consumer durables stocks - pulling down their shares by as much as 5.46 per cent on the BSE. Overall, weak set of earnings from auto firms and selling in banks marked the tone of domestic indices. The Sensex touched an intra-day high of 36,124.26 and low of 35,665.15. It finished 368.84 points, or 1.02 per cent, down at 35,656.70. While, the broader NSE Nifty touched a high of 10,804.45 during the day and fell to a low of 10,630.95. It finally ended 119, or 1.10 per cent, down at 10,661.55. Among the Sensex losers, Yes Bank tumbled 5.46 per cent, followed by Bajaj Finance 5.40, ICICI Bank 3.82 per cent, IndusInd Bank 3.10 per cent and HeromotoCorp 2.55 per cent. Besides domestic factors, concerns related to ongoing US-China trade tussle kept investors jittery. Global macro concerns are front and centre today, as investors focus on the Fed meeting, and US-China trade talks take centre stage. Markets across the globe remained weak and Indian markets were no exception with a 1.1 per cent fall in Nifty and 2.1 per cent fall in Midcap Index, Sunil Sharma, Chief Investment Officer, Sanctum Wealth Management, said. The BSE Sensex had Friday lost 169 points. In the last two sessions, it has lost 537 points. The Indian rupee remained under pressure trading at 71.11 per US dollar and it has struggled to appreciate beyond 71 in recent days, he said.

Other losers on the Sensex were - Sun Pharma, Bajaj Auto, Vedanta, Axis Bank, ITC, Tata Steel, HDFC, Mahindra and Mahindra, Reliance, SRI, Tata Motors, Bharati Airtel, HUL, HDFC Bank, Kotak Bank, Infosys, ONGC and Maruti. Rucking the trend, TCS emerged as the biggest gainer with 1.71 per cent gain on the Sensex. Other winners were Coal India, Larsen and Toubro, PowerGrid, Asian Paint, HCL Tech and NTPC - rising up to 1.61 per cent. Meanwhile, shares of Zee Entertainment Enterprises bounced back Monday and ended with a sharp gain of nearly 17 per cent after the company denied links with a firm being probed for suspicious demeritisation deposits. Its stock zoomed 16.64 per cent to end at Rs 372.60 on the BSE. Intra-day, shares surged 19.24 per cent to Rs 380.80 apiece. Sector-wise, BSE Finance Index declined 2.1 per cent, Healthcare Index fell over 2 per cent. On the flipside, BSE Tech Index was top gainer, up 0.8 per cent. Meanwhile, the Union Cabinet is expected to soon approve relief package for farmers grappling with falling prices of their crops and to tackle distress in the farm sector, according to sources. The likely relief package is seen as an attempt to assuage the farming community's discontent ahead of the general elections. Experts are of the view that any such populist measures in the budget will derail the government's fiscal consolidation agenda. Elsewhere in Asia, Hong Kong's Hang Seng climbed 0.02 per cent, Korea Kospi fell 0.02 per cent, Japan's Nikkei declined 0.60 per cent and Shanghai Composite Index slipped 0.10 per cent. In the eurozone, Frankfurt's DAX fell 0.28 per cent, while Paris CAC 40 was down 0.36 per cent in late morning deals. While, London's FTSE gained 0.04 per cent. Meanwhile, the Indian rupee was trading higher by 9 paise to 71.08 against the US dollar. Brent crude, the global oil benchmark, was trading lower at USD 60.48 per barrel, down by 1.88 per cent. Trai recommendations on OTT issue likely by Feb-end: R S Sharma

NEW DELHI, JAN 28/--/Telecom regulator Trai hopes to finalise, by February end, its recommendations on whether over the top (OTT) services, such as WhatsApp and Skype, should be brought under the regulatory ambit, according to a top official. "We will be organising open house discussions soon. And hopefully by the end of the next month, we should be able to come up with recommendations," Trai Chairman R S Sharma told PTI in an interview. In November last year, the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (Trai) initiated a consultation to explore the regulatory framework for OTT apps such as WhatsApp, Facebook and Google Duo that provide calling and messaging services similar to that by mobile operators. Trai also sought public opinion on whether the

same rules should be applied to OTT applications as are applied in telecom operators. This has been a long pending demand of telecom operators. Players such as WhatsApp and Facebook have come under the scrutiny of policymakers over issues including data breach and fake news, and any new regulation or licensing requirement is expected to increase pressure on such platforms. Mobile operators' association COAI has said the highly taxed telecom industry invested heavily in licence fee, spectrum, telecom equipment and security apparatus, is on an "unequal footing with unregulated OTTs" that offer similar voice, video and data services without regulatory cost. In its written submission to the regulator, the Cellular Operators' Association of India (COAI) has said the

OTT players should be licensed by introducing OTT Communication Authorisation under the unified licence. Baiting for the 'same service, same rules', COAI said that in case similar obligations are not applied to OTT players, a new set of rules or obligations should be adopted for the telecom service providers also. On the other hand, the Internet and Mobile Association of India (IAMAI) and the Broadband India Forum (BIF) have opposed the position by telecom operators that OTT services be brought under the licensing and regulatory ambit. IMAI said legacy telecommunication regulations should not be automatically extended to online applications because of the fundamental "technical and business differences" between traditional services and apps.

European stocks retreat as traders brace for China-US talks

LONDON, JAN 28/--/Europe's stock markets slid Monday on jitters over looming high-level trade talks between China and the United States. Around 1115 GMT, Frankfurt and London each shed 0.2 per cent while Paris slipped 0.4 per cent. The pound dropped against the dollar ahead of Tuesday's vote on British Prime Minister Theresa May's revised Brexit deal, with many believing that even if it is kicked out by MPs, Britain will still not leave the European Union without an agreement. There is a growing sense that May will seek a delay in the country's leaving date to give her more time to reach a deal. Oil prices shed about one dollar, while earlier in Asia, stock markets closed mixed as investors look ahead to a week chock-full of crucial events. "European stocks are slightly in the red... as dealers tread lightly ahead of the latest US-China trade talks that are set to take place this week," said CMC Markets UK analyst David Madden. "The mood is subdued as the gulf between the two sides is still wide, and some traders are

content to play the wait and see game." Hopes that a deal can be struck between the world's top two economies have helped fuel a rally this month in global equities, which had been hammered in December. While there have been conflicting reports on the likelihood of an agreement to end the trade war, analysts say it is in the interests of both sides to reach a deal, with China's economy stuttering and President Donald Trump gearing up for his re-election campaign. "Although coming to an agreement is still tricky, both sides have little incentives to escalate tensions," said Tai Hui, chief market strategist for Asia-Pacific at JP Morgan Asset Management. "Markets will at least expect an extension of the truce in tariff increases beyond early March, while more difficult issues are still being worked on by both sides." As well as the Wednesday-Thursday meeting in Washington, dealers also have in their sights the Federal Reserve's latest policy meeting, where the central bank's statement will be pored over for an idea about its interest rate plans.

Will be unconstitutional for govt to present full budget: Yashwant Sinha

NEW DELHI, JAN 28/--/Former finance minister Yashwant Sinha Monday said it would be "entirely improper and unconstitutional" if the Modi government presents a full budget ahead of the Lok Sabha polls, as he asked it to stick to the convention of outgoing dispensations presenting an interim budget. A strong critic of the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance government, Sinha also accused it of "dressing up" economic figures despite the country facing an "unprecedented" agrarian distress, employment not picking up and the huge non-

performing asset (NPA) problem being not tackled the way it should have been. Interacting with reporters at an event in Indian Women's Press Corps, he said Priyanka Gandhi's entry into active politics will have a positive impact and strengthen the Congress. Taking a swipe at the government over present economic conditions, he said it would now claim by "tweaking" figures ahead of the general election that "river of milk" is flowing in the country and people were never happier. Amid speculation that the government may present a full budget on February 1, Sinha said there is no precedence of an outgoing government doing so.
