

## Programme Specific Outcomes

### Department of Sanskrit

Sanskrit Language and Literature has a very rich heritage and it is one of the prominent languages of the IE language group. It is a medium to provide profound knowledge about ancient Indian society, culture, religion through its text. The academic programme of both Honours and General degree courses are designed to enhance not only professional skill but also develop a deep understanding of the incredible heritage of India through various Sanskrit texts.

- Develop a strong concept of ancient Indian history, philosophy and literature
- Enhance communication skills-Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing.
- Students will be able to write Devnagari scripts which provide them palaeographical knowledge to read out the script of modern languages like Hindi and Marathi.
- Students will learn the skill needed to participate in conversation that builds knowledge with collaboration.
- Reasonable understanding of multi-disciplinary relevance of literature of Sanskrit like Veda, Philosophy, Grammar, Kavya, Dharmashastra etc.
- To make them eligible for higher education.
- After becoming graduate students can apply in the field of UPSE, WBCS etc. And also, after postgraduation they can apply against teaching posts in schools, colleges and other educational institutions.
- The basic computer awareness programme will make them eligible for different kinds of computer-oriented jobs.
- Typing in Unicode will make the students eligible for jobs like preservation and digitization of Sanskrit Text, Web Publishing in archaeological survey of India, Asiatic Society.
